ASSIGNMENT

In this project, you create a multi-page website using WordPress that will be hosted on HACVita.com. Your website should be professional in nature and showcase your skills, talents, and experiences.

FORMAT

The website should be built in WordPress. The site must contain the following:

- A title that includes your name
- A functional navigation system
- At least 4 pages including an "About" page and a "Sample Work" page. (You may change the titles of these pages, but it must be obvious from the design and content what that these pages are included.)
- At least 2 images
- At least 2 links to outside content
